- 2. Can I honestly share my own personal experience concerning any of those without giving the impression I am stating the "AA opinion"?
- 3. What in AA history gave rise to our Tenth Tradition?
- 4. Have I had a similar experience in my own AA life?
- 5. What would AA be without this Tradition? Where would I be?
- 6. Do I breach this or any of its supporting Traditions in subtle, perhaps unconscious, ways?
- 7. How can I manifest the spirit of this Tradition in my personal life outside AA? Inside AA?

# WAI INTERGROUP OFFICE PARKING NOTICE

The parking lot for the WAI offices is on the side of building and requires an access code —or action by office staff—to open the gate allowing entry. Call the office at the entry gate kiosk and office personnel will remotely open the gate for you.

If the office does not answer, please try again in a few seconds as office staff may be on the phone and unable to immediately acknowledge your call, and also confirm that your visit is during open office hours. No code is required to exit the lot. The parking lot in the rear of the building is now for employee's only and requires a badge for entry.

SPREAD the word: DON'T park in the attended lot across the street. The lot is private parking only and is not for Intergroup visitors. WAI office personnel CANNOT validate a parking ticket for that lot. The lot attendant WILL charge you \$15 to exit the lot without a validated ticket!

There are far too many people in very early sobriety at Treatment Facilities that are not hearing the message that we are responsible for carrying. With that said the WAI Treatment Facilities Committee is asking for your help.
