5. Am I willing to help a newcomer go to any lengths -- his lengths, not mine -- to stay sober?

6. Do I share my knowledge of AA tools with other members who may not have heard of them?

We DO give meeting information, talk and listen to another sober alcoholic in danger of picking up a drink, a sober alcoholic visiting the area who doesn't know anyone around here or a drunk who just needs that link in the chain to get them to go to a meeting.

One year of sobriety is suggested, along with touch-tone phone service and 3 or more hours a week to answer the phone when the office is closed.


