At the November 12th Delegates Meeting, we will be voting in our new Officers and appointing our new Committee Chairpeople.

- Alternate Treasurer (rotates to Treasurer the following year) Assists the Treasurer with financial reporting and reconciliation
- Trustee Steering Committee member, helps make decisions about day-today operations of the office
- Public Information Attends functions to represent AA (what it is and is not)
- Liaison to Area 30 relays information between the WAI meeting and the Area
 30 meeting once a month
