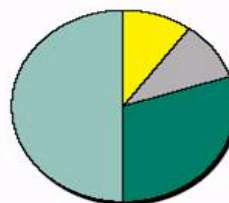
The following is an excerpt from the Self Support pamphlet with recommendations for distributing funds. *This is only suggested and each group has the right to it’s own group conscience for distribution.*

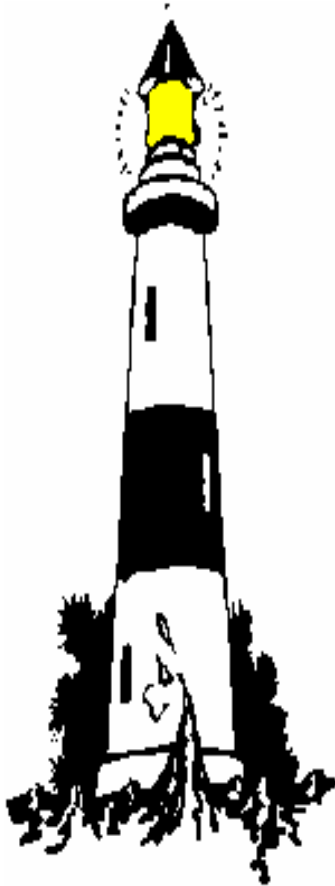

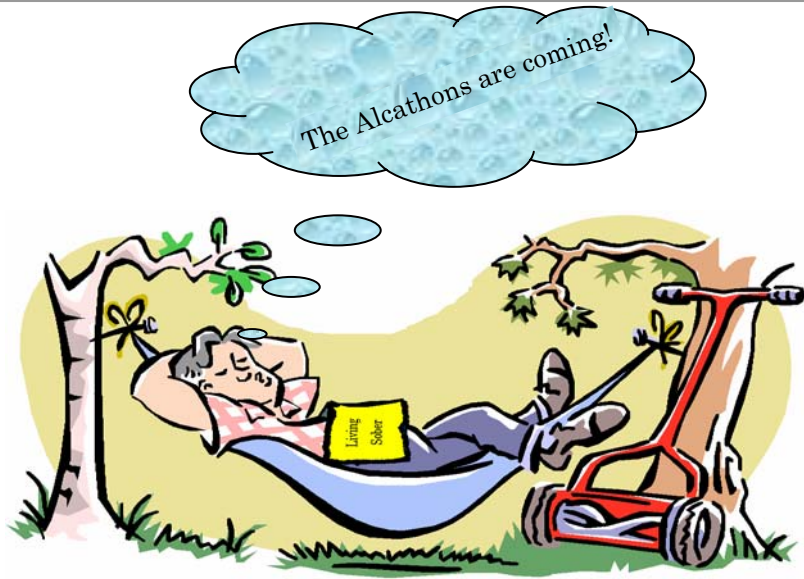

**What is Bridging the Gap?**

Simply put, a temporary contact is an A.A. member or group who works closely with clients who are being released from a treatment facility and helps them to **bridge the gap** to Alcoholics Anonymous in the local Community.

My experience has been that it is an honor and privilege to receive a call on the 800 # from someone being discharged from a treatment facility looking for that first contact with the outside. There is a guideline that this is basic 12th step work. Always use two people when making contact with our newcomer, at least one should have a year of sobriety. Guys with guys, gals with gals.
