
Calling all Groups!

As of May 13, 2004 Contributions from groups to Worcester Area Intergroup were *down by \$4450.62* from the comparable period last year. We are still financially sound but if this trend continues we may have to find ways to cut costs. Many groups who contributed in the past have suddenly stopped sending contributions.


