Boston Pre-release	430 Canterbury St., Roslindale, MA 02131	Boston Pre-Release Center (BPRC) is a minimum and pre-release facility housing criminally sentenced males.
Bridgewater State Hospital	20 Administration Rd., Bridgewater, MA 02324	Bridgewater State Hospital (BSH) is a medium security facility housing male patients in two categories: civil commitments without criminal sentences, and on occasion, pre-trial detainees sent for competency and criminal responsibility evaluations by the court.
Lemuel Shattuck Hospital Correctional Unit	180 Morton St., Jamaica Plain, MA 02130	Lemuel Shattuck Hospital Correctional Unit (LSH) is a medium security correctional unit within the Lemuel Shattuck Hospital providing secure inpatient and outpatient medical care to male and female inmates from both the state and county.
MASAC at Plymouth	Myles Standish State Forest, Bump Pond Rd., Plymouth, MA 02360	The Massachusetts Alcohol and Substance Abuse Center, also known as MASAC at Plymouth, is a unique facility that houses civilly committed male patients participating in an up to 90-day detoxification program. The Department's current inmate and patient healthcare vendor, Wellpath, is responsible for all patient management services as of May 2020. These responsibilities include: all day-to-day interaction with patients by non-uniformed clinically trained staff, Opioid Treatment Program (OTP) services, mental health programming services, on-site safety operations and emergency trips. The Department is responsible for the perimeter security of the facility, scheduled trips, and maintenance of the physical structures.
Massachusetts Treatment Center	30 Administration Rd., Bridgewater, MA 02324	The Massachusetts Treatment Center (MTC) is a medium security facility separately housing criminally sentenced male inmates identified as sex offenders and those who have been civilly committed as sexually dangerous persons.
MCI Cedar Junction	MCI-Cedar Junction, Route 1A, Main Street P.O. Box 100, South Walpole, MA 02071	MCI-Cedar Junction (MCI-CJ) is a maximum security facility with a medium component, housing criminally sentenced males. The Department Disciplinary Unit (DDU) for the most serious discipline issues is also located here.

MCI Framingham	99 Loring Dr., P.O. Box 9007, Framingham, MA 01701	MCI-Framingham (MCI-F) is a medium security reception and diagnostic center housing females. It provides a comprehensive network of programming for women who are serving criminal sentences, awaiting trial, or are civilly committed.
MCI Norfolk	2 Clark St., P.O. Box 43, Norfolk, MA 02056	MCI-Norfolk (MCI-N) is the largest medium security level facility in Massachusetts, housing criminally sentenced males.
MCI Shirley	104 Harvard Road, Shirley, MA 01464	MCI-Shirley (MCI-S) is a medium and minimum security facility housing criminally sentenced males.
North Central Correctional Institution	500 Colony Rd., P.O. Box 466, Gardner, MA 01440	North Central Correctional Institution (NCCI) is a medium/minimum security facility housing criminally sentenced males.
Northeastern Correctional Center (Concord farm pre-release)	976 Barretts Mill Rd., P.O. Box 1069, West Concord, MA 01742	Northeastern Correctional Center (NECC) is a minimum and pre-release facility housing criminally sentenced males.
Old Colony Correctional Center	1 Administration Rd., Bridgewater, MA 02324	Old Colony Correctional Center (OCCC) is a medium and minimum security facility focused on mental health with the objective of providing services more efficiently while at the same time promoting rehabilitation and re-entry.
Pondville Correctional Center	1 Industries Dr., P.O. Box 146, Norfolk, MA 02056	Pondville Correctional Center (PCC) is a minimum and pre-release facility for criminally sentenced males.

BARNSTABLE COUNTY		
Barnstable County Jail and House of Correction	6000 Sheriff's Place, Buzzards Bay, MA 02532	Barnstable County House of Correctional is a minimum-security Adult in Bourne, Barnstable County, Massachusetts. The 600-bed capacity facility has been operational since 1983 and boasts of about 3223 bookings yearly. This Adult facility hosts inmates from all of Barnstable County under the governorship of the Massachusetts Sherriff.
BRISTOL COUNTY		
Bristol County Ash Street Jail and House of Corrections	400 Faunce Corner Road, North Dartmouth, MA 02747	This eleven hundred (1100) bed facility houses male inmates convicted of crimes with a sentence of 2 ½ years or less; higher security female inmates or pre-trial detainees, and higher security male pre-trial detainees. The facility is comprised of several decentralized housing units with varying levels of security, a medical unit, and a 400 bed Modular Unit housing sentenced inmates who have progressed through an accountability based classification system to earn a spot in the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Unit, the Pre-Release Program, and the Work Crews.
Bristol County Women's Center	400 Faunce Corner Road, North Dartmouth, MA 02747	Bristol County Women's Center is a medium-security Adult in North Dartmouth, Bristol County, Massachusetts. The 106-bed capacity facility has been operational since 1986 and boasts of about 4882 bookings yearly. This Adult facility hosts inmates from all of Bristol County under the governorship of the Massachusetts Sherriff.

ESSEX COUNTY		
Middleton House of Corrections	20 Manning Ave. Middleton, MA 01949	Essex County Correctional Facility is mainly a pretrial holding facility in Middleton, Massachusetts. Essex County Correctional Facility is a 1000-bed capacity maximum-security facility located at 20 Manning Avenue, Middleton, MA, 01949-2807. ECCF holds Essex County inmates accused of misdemeanor offenses who cannot make bail or await their court dates. Essex County facility accepts detainees arrested by the Essex County Sheriffs Department Secure Alternative Lockup Program deputies, the Middleton Police Department and federal agencies.
Essex County Pre-Release and Re-Entry Center	165 Marston St. Lawrence, MA 01841	The Essex County Pre-release and Re-entry Center (ECPRC) in Lawrence houses inmates with less serious records as well as those who are approaching the end of their sentences and have earned the privilege of being transferred to the lower-security facility. The staff provide reintegration services for inmates as part of the re-entry process allowing them to work their way from the Middleton facility to the ECPRC. As a pre-release facility it requires inmates to have added responsibilities including increased program requirements and class participation, as well as additional work assignments, community service or work release.

It is for persons identified by supervising courts or ECSD staff as benefitting from enhanced community support, accountability, and reentry planning.

Women In Transition	197 Elm St. Salisbury, MA 01952	WIT is a minimum security and pre-release facility in Salisbury dedicated to females, serving women with drug and alcohol addictions. The facility provides programs and services to prepare women for life after incarceration by assisting offenders in obtaining the resources and skills they will need to successfully reintegrate into society. Various programming components include individual and group counseling, education, employment, and community service assignments.
MIDDLESEX COUNTY		
Middlesex Jail and House of Correction	269 Treble Cove Road, Billerica, MA 01862	The Middlesex Jail & House of Correction is situated approximately 45 minutes north of downtown Boston in the town of Billerica, Massachusetts. Accredited by the American Correctional Association (ACA) and the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCCHC), the facility houses men awaiting trial and serving sentences of up to 2 ½ years, as well as women classified to the office's pre-release center.
NORFOLK COUNTY		
Norfolk County Correctional Center	200 West Street PO Box 149, Dedham, MA 02026	The Norfolk County Correctional Center is medium prison office in the Norfolk County and is arranged on 5 sections of land in metropolitan Dedham. The facility has 502 beds. On average, there are 140 inmates who are serving sentences and 260 inmates waiting for trial.

SUFFOLK COUNTY	South Bay House of Correction	20 Bradston Street Boston, MA 02118	The Suffolk County facility houses adult male and female inmates convicted of crimes with a sentence of 2½ years or less. During their incarceration, sentenced inmates have the opportunity to participate in a number of programs, which include: substance abuse programming, anger management, vocational training, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), educational courses ranging from basic literacy to college prep classes, job skills, parenting skills and reintegration programming.
WORCESTER COUNTY	Substance Treatment Opportunity Program (STOP)	5 Paul X. Tivnan Drive, West Boylston, MA 01583	“This is about a support network of inmates helping each other with our incredible staff to get people ready so when they re-enter, they can do it without fear, or at least have the tools to handle anything that comes at them,” Evangelidis said. “Our goal for them and prayer for them is that they will never go back that way and live a life of sobriety.” S.T.O.P. is a 6-month, intensive Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment program accommodating up to 24 inmates in a modified therapeutic community environment at Worcester County Jail & House of Correction. The program curriculum includes evidence-based practices from various sources, primarily consisting of cognitive behavioral therapy and courses developed by Hazelden.
Worcester County Jail and House of Correction		5 Paul X. Tivnan Drive, West Boylston, MA 01583	The Worcester County Jail is a medium-security county facility located in West Boylston, Massachusetts. Like most county jails, the Worcester Sheriff’s Department oversees this facility’s operations. The facility’s main mission is to provide a safe and secure environment for both the correctional officers and the inmates. Being a county jail, Worcester County Jail and House of Correction holds inmates who are sentenced for not longer than three years. This means that the inmates serving longer than a 3-year sentence do their remaining time in other state or federal prisons.
