Cathy H. read the Safety Card.

**Secretary's Report (Wendy S.):** Written report was distributed and accepted as presented.

**Treasurer's Report (William S.):** Report was read and accepted as presented.

**Office Manager's Report (Brandy H.):** May contributions (\$3,997.13) were down about \$300 from April, and product (\$3,497.60) were up about \$80. However, both are down, year on year, by \$6,860.81 and \$3,202.56 respectively. New meeting lists are in. The office will be closed on July 4, a Saturday. Cathy H. requested that Brandy include new meeting lists in the delegate packets for next month's meeting.

**Website (Fred F.):** Web hosting fees and expenses for the year are \$295.50 with web site visitors up more than 30% from April, while average page views per visit are down 14.7% from April. Pages have been updated appropriately and Navigation Buttons enhanced.

**Beacon:** Open.

**Alcathon (Jenn D.):** Considerable discussion on committee buying supplies, with Brandy pointing out stock in office vault and WAI's BJ's card as a non-profit. Jenn indicated only wanting one Big Book per hour from WAI. Discussion about budget. Brandy and Jenn commit to speaking to clarity.

**HALTline (Naomi D.):** The new Grasshopper system is working well. Brandy is handling computer changes and Naomi is handling schedules and member contact lists. Coverage is active whenever the WAI office is closed.

**Area 30 (Jeff L.):** Reported from the Area 30 Post Conference Assembly on May 16, 2026. Financial information included that Group Numbers are now 9 digits, not 6 digits as previously, affecting how contributions are made. Also included were highlights of the Delegates report from the 76th General Service Conference (more on Area 30 website) including that, of 1,424 active groups in Eastern MA, only 27.53% contribute to General Services; a 5th Edition of the Big Book was approved with minor changes and some new stories; and AA World Services is phasing out printed versions of the Final Conference Reports.

**District 25 (Paul B.):** Discussed open and newly filled positions, and reported that the Area 30 Delegate went over Conference Advisory Actions of the 76th General Service Conference. Also noted concerns with paper meeting lists being inaccurate despite website being updated.

**District 26 (Charlie S.):** Also discussed concerns with printed lists. General discussion on how to submit changes. (On-line for both. Fred updates website; Brandy updates master list for printing.) Planned activities include a trip to WooSox. They are also discussing hosting an Area Assembly.

**Public Information:** Open.

**Social:** Open.

**Zoom (Brandy):** April: 251 meetings with 1975 participants. May: 274 meetings with 2027 participants.

**Old Business:** Open positions include: Beacon; Public Information; Social.

**New Business:**

- ◆ Billy B. appointed by Chairperson Cathy Hamilton as Chair of Public Information Committee.
- ◆ Charlie asked Brandy if there is a 12 Step Workbook. She informed him there is not an AA workbook, but Hazelden has one.

- ◆ Lynne reported she is available to any group or district interested in her bringing the display triptych she created about WAI, what it does and doesn't do.
- ◆ Brandy reported the Area Delegate wants to update us on the recent General Services Conference. Decided on next months board meeting.

**What's On Your Mind:** Bill G. reported on the AA Massachusetts State Convention being held November 6-8, 2026. Western Massachusetts is running this year's convention. The website has room availability and prices. Help is needed on the Planning Committee. The next meeting is the last Tuesday of July, Best Western Hotel, Marlboro, 7:00 PM
