Secretary's Report (Wendy S.): Report was distributed, reviewed, and accepted as presented.

Treasurer's Report (William S.): Report was read an accepted. Report included several graphs which were discussed. Chairperson Ted K. encouraged attendees to promote contributions in meetings.

Office Manager's Report (Brandy H.): July contributions at \$3884.72 were down \$2082.93 from June. July product sales at \$3127.90 were down \$124.84 from June.
